GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION LEGITIMATE INTEREST POLICY NOTICE

In line with the new GDPR, the Abergavenny and District Civic Society (ACDS) gives notice that we intend to ensure the privacy of the data you have given us, under the Regulation's Legitimate Interest section.

The Society takes your privacy seriously. We will use the personal information you have given us for the following purposes only:

1. To provide you with notice of meetings, activities, events and information that might be of interest to members.
2. To send out updates, newsletters or information that is relevant to the membership, in line with our Aims and Objectives.

ACDS retains and manages information supplied by members, as itemised in the Society's Membership Application Form eg name, address, telephone number and email address. This data can only be accessed by Executive members and is password protected. At no stage will members' data be passed on to any other party.

Members' data will be used in a way that they would reasonably expect and that will not adversely impact their privacy. We will protect members' rights and interests with regard to their data.

The Society's Legitimate Interests are to inform members of activities, meetings, and events including broader social benefits to members.

We will therefore process data as necessary for the purposes of our Legitimate Interests, whilst protecting members' personal information. We will process, (send you information), by digital means, as it is the most appropriate way to achieve our purpose. Due diligence will be applied to ensure individual members' rights and interests are proportionate, fully considered and protected.

If any member objects in any way to their data being held by the Society, he/she should inform the Society and we will cease processing it forthwith.

The Society will review its "Legitimate Interest Notice" when there are any changes in the purpose, nature or context of the processing
